Senior Year

Fall

- Take [SAT](#) and/or [ACT](#) and have official scores sent to colleges by collegeboard.com and/or actstudent.org.
- Attend [Senior Night](#).
- Continue building your list of colleges to research ([Naviance Supermatch](#)).
-Student athletes: Review the [NCAA Process](#) -Review audition process if applying to [VPA program](#)
- Narrow your college list to fewer than 8-10 schools and add to "Colleges I'm Applying To" list on [Naviance](#) and sync [Common App](#) with [Naviance](#)
- Create/update a resume based on your list of activities. Template on [Naviance](#), under Document Resources.
- Finalize College Essays.
- Attend [Financial Aid Night](#) and [Free Application for Federal Student Aid \(FAFSA\) Workshops](#).
- Complete your [Florida Financial Aid Application \(FFAA\)](#) for [Bright Futures Scholarship](#) (Application opens October 1st of Senior Year).
- Create [FAFSA ID](#) and apply for Financial Aid (FAFSA application opens October 1st of Senior Year).
- Ask references for letters of recommendation and submit request in [Naviance](#).
- Complete and submit college applications by posted deadlines, update in [Naviance](#) and request official transcripts be sent through [Naviance & School Counselor](#).
- Complete SSAR if applicable
- Start researching and applying for scholarships on [Naviance](#), EdFoundationSRQ.org/scholarships, and/or GoingMerry.com

Spring

- Maintain second semester grades.
- Monitor email for next steps of admissions process.
- Finalize community service hours for [Bright Futures Scholarship](#) (submit completed service hours paperwork to the Student Success Center before graduation).
- Keep researching and applying for scholarships on [Naviance](#), or EdFoundationSRQ.org/scholarships
- Update [Naviance](#) with admission decisions and report scholarship awards to the Student Success Center and school counselor office.
