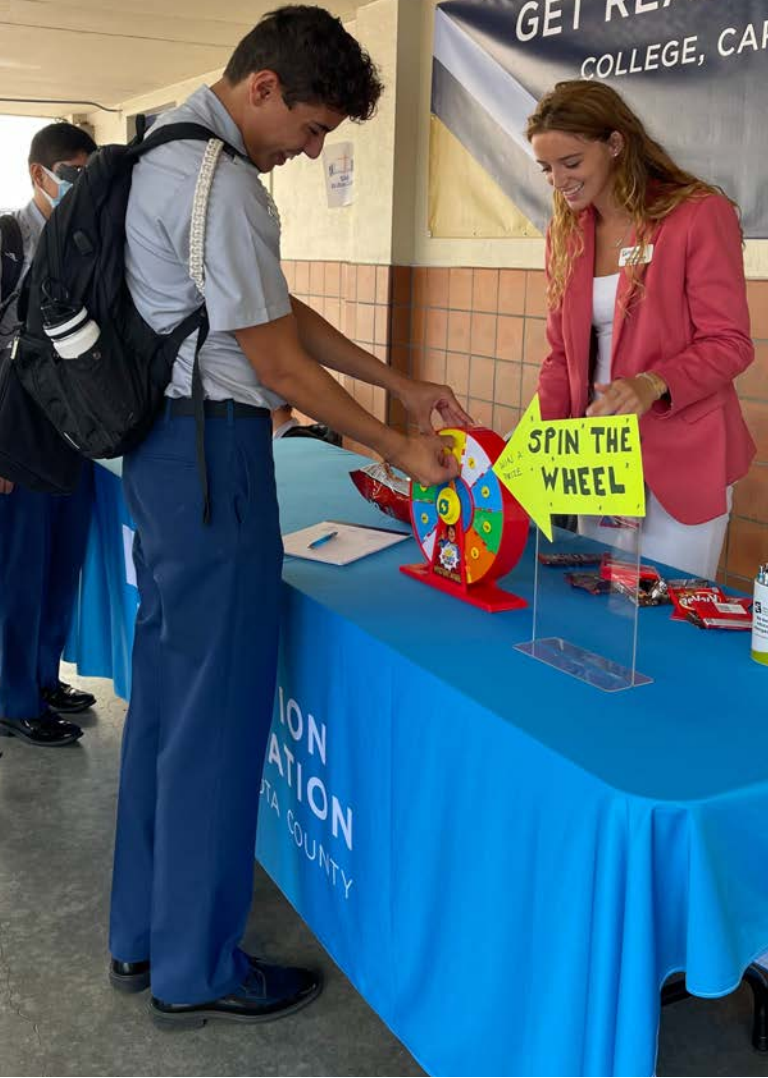

Student Success Checklist

SOPHOMORE YEAR

Fall

- Grades count for your future, so start strong and work hard! Reach out to teachers for additional academic support.
- Visit EdFoundationSRQ.org/Students for tools and resources.
- Explore colleges online, take notes, and register on college websites to be notified of their visits in your area.
- Create and maintain a resume that highlights your activities, academics, and volunteer service. Find a template here: Bit.ly/EFSC-Resume-Template.
- Get involved in a club or organization that meets your interests. Consider assuming a leadership role or involvement in a community impact project.
- Continue to follow Florida Bright Futures service requirements. Review requirements per Florida Financial Aid office by visiting FloridaStudentFinancialAidSG.org. Check-in with your high school coordinator for the approval process.

Spring & Summer

- Maintain your second-semester grades.
- Register for 11th-grade classes. Select classes that meet or challenge your level of academic rigor.
- Submit paperwork for over 30 hours of completed community or work service to your high school coordinator.
- Student-athletes: Review the NCAA process.
- Plan for summer activities.
- Explore job shadow opportunities in areas of interest. Develop and implement a project to explore interests, skills, and talents.
- Utilize the summer for SAT and/or ACT test prep.
- Continue completing service hours.
